As the Board has decided, due to coronavirus issues, that there will be no Annual Awards for 2020, Boreal West and all trials in 2020 will be Fun Trials. If you are thinking about trying a different line in the future, now, or at any trial upcoming this year, might be a good time to give it a go. You won't be jeopardizing you points standing in 2020.

And while Covid-19 is rampaging in some parts of California, we are asking everyone to social distance by maintaining a distance of at least six feet from everyone. If that is not possible, then please wear a mask (please bring a mask for everyone in your party). Because signups and checking pose a real problem in this regard, we will be modifying the sign up and scoring procedure to be a "no touch" process. Rider fees will be \$20 for everyone (except kids), regardless of PITS Membership card color. Also, checking will be anything from "self-check" to "group check". If you are comfortable riding with one or more riders, then group check. If your situation makes this uncomfortable for you, then self check. We will have awards, but they might not be presented on Saturday as we will have to do the tallying in a safe manner. If we cannot complete overnight for Sunday awards, we will have them at the next event.

I know that many have differing thoughts on how safe each of us needs to be. We are trying to accommodate all perspectives. We hope everyone will have a great ride and enjoy themselves. Really, no pressure, other than self-imposed.

The Saturday loop is very short, mostly shaded sites, great for spectating.

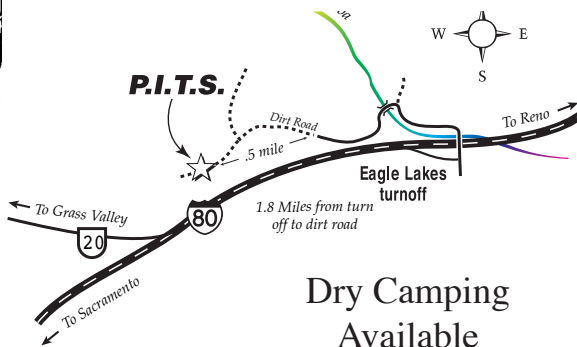

### Motorcycle Classes:

1. **Twin Shock** - Any model year bike with twin-shock rear suspension
2. **Modern Bike** - Any modern single shock trials type machine.
3. **Junior** - Any rider 14 years and younger, riding any type of machine.
4. **Trail Bike Class** - Line 4 & 3 only. Designed for lower performance air cooled trail bikes with a maximum of 250 cc (no motocross or high performance trail bikes) This class is intended for introducing trail riders into riding trials without have to buy a trials bike. These bikes will not be forced to use trials type tires at most locations but are recommended.

Each motorcycle class will have at least four levels of difficulty:

0. Exhibition
1. Master
2. Advanced
3. Intermediate
4. Novice
